Throughout the week we spend together in Baltimore, there are several things that we want you to know.

Chapter Arrival/Flight Information

We are requesting arrival information for chapters. Please complete the [Nevada FBLA NLC Arrival Information Form](#). This form should be completed by Thursday, June 21.

Hotel Keys, Tickets and State Items

Hotel keys will not be available before 3:00 pm on June 27. Key pickup, along with t-shirts, tickets and other state items will be held on June 27 from 3:00 pm until 11:00 pm. *More information on the exact location will be coming soon.*

Early/Late Arrivals

If you are arriving prior to hotel key pickup, please store your bags with the bell stand. If you will not arrive at the hotel until after 11:00 pm by what is listed on your arrival form, we will contact you for additional instructions, but most likely your packets will be at the front desk for you upon arrival.

Nevada State Days

Nevada State Day will take place on June 28. Meet in the lobby area no later than 10:00 am. Buses will depart at 10:15 am. Buses will depart from Six Flags at 7:00 pm. This is an ideal day to wear your state t-shirt.

The state day activity does include a voucher for a meal, but you will want to bring additional money for beverages, snacks and souvenirs. Please note that your ticket does include the water park. Plan on bringing a beach towel (not your hotel towel) and a change of clothes with you. Lockers are available for rent. Leaving items on the buses is not an option.
