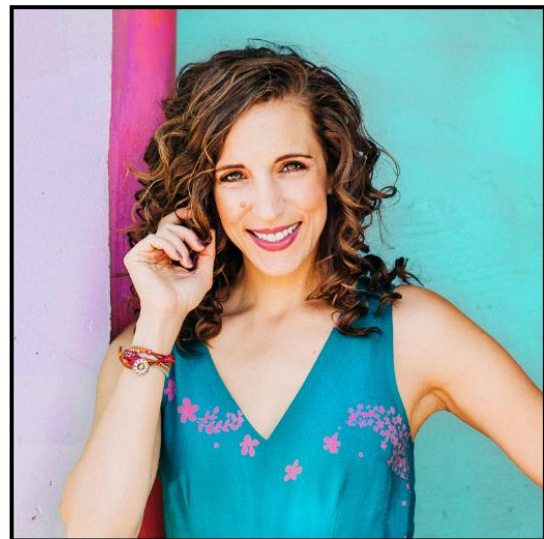

Voting Delegates

Each chapter receives two State Voting Delegates to elect statewide candidates (President/Executive Vice President/Vice President of Membership) and vote on bylaws. Each chapter receives Chapter Voting Delegates who elect the Region Vice President based on chapter membership. Results of the election are announced at the conclusion of the voting sessions. Be sure that your chapter assigns the proper number of delegates to participate in the election process:

Number of Chapter Voting Delegates

20 Members or Less	2 delegates
21-50 members	3 delegates
51-100 members	4 delegates
101-150	5 delegates

*Each additional 50 members
shall have one additional vote*

Team Performance in Zoom

A team competing in any presentation/performance/demonstration event that involves live judging via Zoom may present to the judges in one of the following ways:

- Using separate accounts from separate locations with the Event Administrator moving the competitors as a group
- Using one account with all competitors in the same location

FBLA advises using appropriate precautions and following any guidelines and restrictions as set forth by the CDC, your local/state governments, or your specific educational institution.

Team Objective Testing

Where collaborative objective tests are concerned, teams will take test individually and FBLA will average the scores of the team members.

- If a registered team member(s) does not log in and take the test, the scores of only the remaining team member(s) will be averaged
- The team member(s) who did not take the test forfeit their eligibility for the remainder of the event; they will be dropped from the team and will not be allowed to continue in competition





Breaking Ties

Ties will be broken in the following order:

1. Judges Determination
2. Online Test Result – the last 10 questions, followed by time
3. Pre-Judged Materials

Live Competition in Zoom

This year, some events will have elements of LIVE competition. This approach is inspired by the updates that some competitions will be LIVE in Zoom at this year's National Leadership Conference.
