# 2023-2024 Nevada Success Series

Nevada FBLA is pleased to announce that the Nevada Success Series (formerly referred to as the Region Success Series) continues this year! The Nevada Success Series will allow members to compete against others from their region in all events with an objective test component.

## Who?

All members of Nevada FBLA are encouraged to participate. This activity is great practice for the State Business Leadership Conference.

## What?

This competition is only open to current Nevada FBLA members. Members compete against others in the state with state-level recognition.

## When?

- Registration will open **November 27** and close at 5:00pm on **January 5**.
- No changes or additions will be made after 5:00pm on January 5.
- Advisers will receive testing instructions and log-in information by **5:00pm on January 12**.
- Testing begins on **January 17**.
- Testing closes promptly at **5:00pm on January 31**.
- There is no late registration for this event.
- Winners will be announced the week of **February 5**.
- Advisers will have access to scores and competency reports the week of **February 12**.

## Where?

Online! For this competition, the requirements are that tests be taken in your school environment and be proctored throughout the entire testing time. There is flexibility in the proctoring role. We do not require a business educator to proctor so you can ask other school staff members to proctor so students can complete tests at a time convenient to everyone.

Winners will be announced and recognized on social media, Nevada FBLA website, and the adviser weekly update. All participants will receive a ribbon at SBLC to showcase their achievement.

## Testing

Testing procedures will be sent to advisers by January 12. After the competition winners are announced, advisers will be able to access scores.

Each test is taken as an individual – there are no collaborative or team events during this online competition.

## Competitions

There is no limit on the number of competitors per event a chapter may have. Each member may participate in 5 (five) online tests.

## Registration Process

The registration fee is \$10 per student for up to 5 tests.

BluePanda will be used for registration and testing. Registration opens November 27. To access BluePanda go to: [app.gobluepanda.com](http://app.gobluepanda.com).

Only FBLA High School or Middle School members are eligible to participate. A member is defined as a student with paid membership in the national system (FBLA Connect).

Select students to participate first, then add the competitions for each student.

**IMPORTANT:** A generic invoice from BluePanda will be automatically generated. **Do not pay the BluePanda invoice!** An official invoice from Nevada FBLA will be sent to the adviser email address listed in the registration process. Invoices from Nevada FBLA for the Nevada Success Series must be paid before the chapter will be able to register for SBLC.
